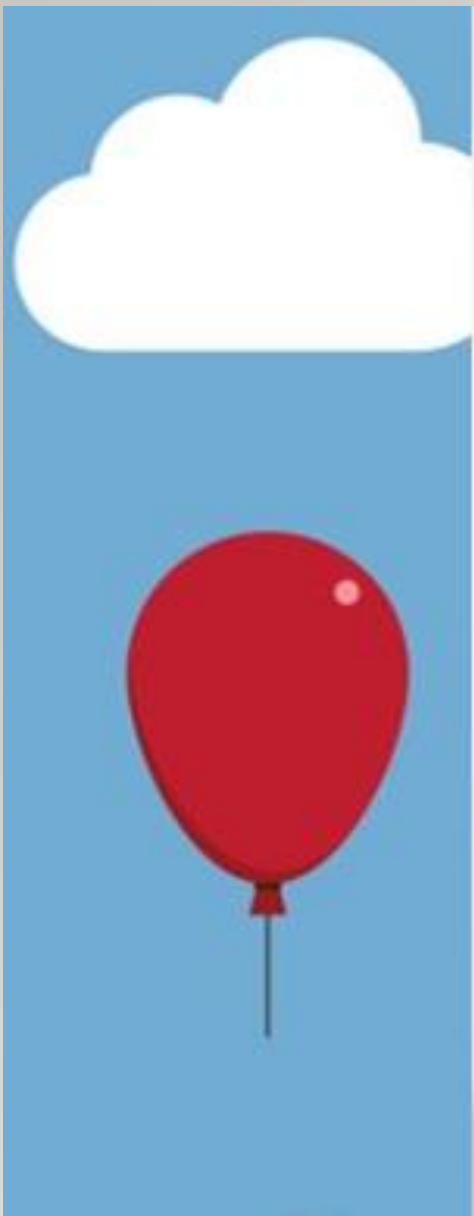

Entry Criteria:

The competition is for two-dimensional work up to A2 in size. Work must be photographed and emailed as a JPEG file. Entries for the Photography category must be submitted as a JPEG file. There is no set theme. Entries in the form of a collage will be accepted but three-dimensional work will not. All entries must be the student's original work. Group pieces will be accepted. Work that had been previously entered for an examination (e.g. 2021 Junior Cert) is eligible but as the student has progressed to a senior class (TY, 5th or 6th year) their entry goes into the Senior section.
