Mental health awareness for parents/guardians

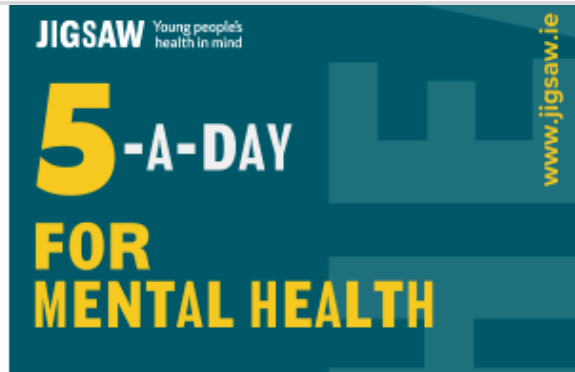
This online course for parents/guardians of Primary and Post-Primary students (+12 years) aims to raise awareness about youth mental health and will take around 40 minutes to complete.

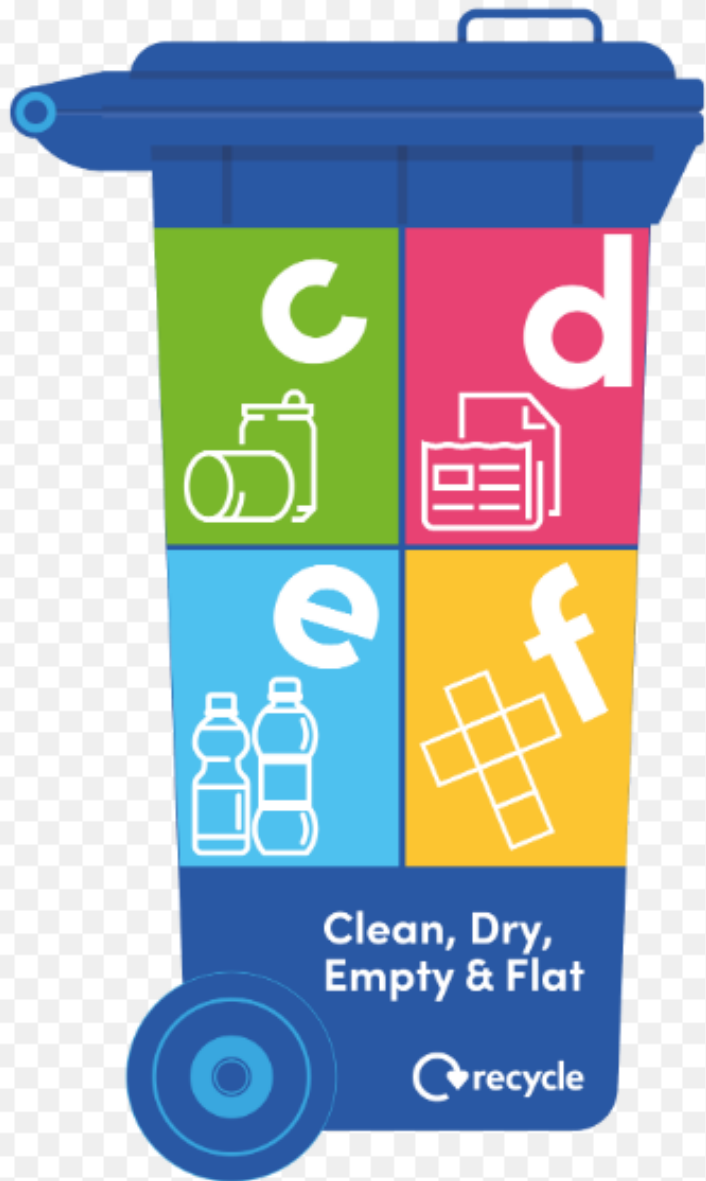

INTEGRITY OF THE SCHOOL DAY

Your son's/daughter's *School Journal* contains a section (Page 18) detailing the procedure for students who need to leave our school and we would be grateful for your continued support for same. ***In brief parents/guardians must collect their child from the main office in order for their child to sign out during the school day due to illness or an urgent medical appointment.*** All routine dental/orthodontic/physiotherapy appointments for students should take place after school. Parents/guardians are asked to re-arrange any existing appointments during the school day, if they are not in a position to collect their child for the appointment and to make all non-urgent medical/dental appointments for outside of school hours. **Appointments signing out process will be fully enforced from 17th April 2023.**

Advice received underpins our need to ensure that a parent / guardian or a nominated adult, present in person to collect the student when a student has a requirement to leave school. Should a student become ill during the school day, the school office staff will make contact with parents / guardians and request that parents collect their son/ daughter. This duty of care will also apply to students who are over 18 years of age and have assumed their own responsibility for guardianship.

SCHOOL TRANSPORT INFORMATION

Information for families regarding School Transport Application Process for 2023/24 School Year

Families are asked to note that the closing date for payment/registering medical cards has been brought forward so that Bus Éireann can process applications, arrange transport and issue tickets to families as soon as possible for the 2023/24 school year.

1. New Applicants – Apply By 28TH APRIL 2023

The Bus Éireann family portal is now open for new applications for school transport services for the 2023/24 school year. New applications are considered as:

- pupils who will be attending junior infants in primary school or first year in post-primary school for the first time in 2023.
- pupils that may move home address or will be attending a new school in the 2023/24 school year

Applications can be made by visiting www.buseireann.ie/schooltransport

The closing date for new applications is **Friday 28 April 2023**. Any new applications made after the closing date are **considered late applications and families are not guaranteed a seat.**

2. All Applicants- payment/enter medical card details – closing date 9 June 2023
