Senior Cycle (TY, 5th and 6th year)

- Skirt/Navy Slacks.... No tracksuit bottoms, leggings or denim
- White collared shirt
- Green School Jumper with V-neck and gold trim (not PE hoodie)
- Black socks
- Black Leather Shoes
- School Jacket



PE Uniform

- Tracksuit bottoms/ leggings of one block colour. One small logo may be present but must be small enough to be covered by a hand.
- School Polo Shirt for 1st 3rdstudents
- Plain block colour full length t-shirt for TY, 5th and 6th years.
- Crop tops are not permitted
- School Hoodie
- If extra layers are worn under the school hoodie, they must be removed if/when the school hoodie is removed. The school hoodie should be the outer most layer at all times

Transition Years

- PE uniform can be worn throughout TY.
- Students must be in FULL senior school uniform for school trips unless told otherwise by Ms. Edmonds.
- Students who report to school in non school uniform for trips will not go on the trip

Match Days/School Trips

- Students must come to school in FULL school uniform on match days/school trips, this includes school jacket and footwear.
- A student who arrives to school in PE gear or non school uniform will not be permitted on the trip/match.
- If students are returning to school for any period of time after a match they are expected to be in FULL school uniform.

Exams

- Students must come to school in FULL school uniform when sitting exams in school, this includes school jacket and footwear.
- A student who arrives to school in PE gear or non school uniform will have to get their full school uniform before being granted access to the exam.


These are NOT all one plain block colour and the logo is NOT small enough to be covered by a hand

School shoes must be plain, flat black leather with non sports sole




Unacceptable School Shoes
