2* Cabin Hotel– or similar

- Students will be accommodated in multi-bedded rooms
 - Teachers will be accommodated in single / twin rooms
- City Tax has been included in the tour price @ 333 ISK per person per night

Coaching:

- Day 1 Pick up from the school and transfer to Dublin Airport
- Day 1 Pick up from airport and transfer to Blue Lagoon, guided tour by coach on the way to the hotel. Evening return coach transfers to/from bowling
- Day 2 8 hours continuous service from your hotel
- Day 3 8 hours continuous service from your hotel
- Day 4 Airport Transfer
- Day 4 Transfer from Dublin Airport to the school

- Cancellations need to be advised in writing - either directly from you or the parent/guardian.

- A non-refundable deposit of €350 is required from each paying person travelling.
- The final tour balance payment must be paid 10 weeks before departure.

DEPOSITS & TOUR PRICE

If you're happy with the quote, please let me know so we can get accommodation & coaching held for you.

Deposits are collected online through a group link created for the St Peters College Dunboyne tour.

The required non-refundable deposit is €350pp. Once tour numbers are finalised and the flights secured, we can confirm the tour price advised on 07 May 2024.

Parents/Guardians then receive an individual link where they can pay off the balance.

CUT-OFF DATES

We recommend setting a date by which the students should have the deposit paid. If a student misses the book-on date, it may be necessary to charge a supplement if the flight price has increased.

PASSPORTS & VISAS

When students pay us online, their passport information goes directly onto our system.

Parents/Guardians can edit this information up to ten weeks before the tour departs.

Having the passport names confirmed by the parents/guardians is important because airlines charge name change fees for any incorrect names provided.

If your students are not paying online, please collect copies of the photo page of their passports.

Irish passport holders do not require a visa for an Iceland tour. However, students who will not be travelling on an EU passport may. It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to ensure that they have a valid passport or visa in time to travel with the group. Irish students <18 (unaccompanied by a parent) cannot travel on passport cards.

LUGGAGE INCLUSION, ADVANCED CHECK-IN & RESERVED SEATING

Most school tours travel with 10 kilos of luggage; if you feel your tour needs more than that, let us know and we'll get that organised.

Some airlines have compulsory online check-in. We will use the passport information we collected via the online payment system in these cases.

We include the cost of seat allocation in the tour price that allows us to check-in the group in advance, where permitted.

YOUR ACCOMMODATION

Unless informed otherwise, students will be in multi-bedded rooms. As the main Group Leader, you will be in a single room. Accompanying teachers will be in twin rooms. If this is not the case, let us know and we'll advise you of the additional cost and get it organised.

Almost all destinations these days have a tourist tax. In most cases, we cannot include this in the tour price because it is payable locally. We've set out the current amount overleaf but it is subject to change.

Many hotels require a security deposit to be paid on check-in and returned on check-out upon inspection of rooms.

TOUR FINANCES

We can provide you with a report of who's booked on and who's paid what. This is real-time information which comes directly from our system. We recommend adding a contingency to the tour price. This can be rebated back to the Group Leader before your group travels. The final balance is due 10 weeks before departure.

TRAVEL INSURANCE

We provide Premier Plus insurance for our School Tours. We'll have the information for the students from the online payment system. To confirm the policy, we'll need the names and DOBs of the 4 adults travelling.
