Dear Fifth Year Parent/Guardian,

We look forward to welcoming your son/daughter back to St Peter's College as a fifth year.

The Board of Management is very mindful of this expensive time of year but further to requests from the Parents Association has given permission for three optional school tours to be offered for fifth years in 2025.

Belfast	Sunday 9 th February to Monday 10 th February 2025	€310	deposit €150
Berlin	Sunday 9 th February to Monday 10 th February 2025	€463	deposit €250
Iceland	Friday 2 nd May to Monday 5 th May 2025	€1330	deposit €350

The balance must be paid 10 weeks before departure. Please read GTI Travel's terms and conditions.

There are 40 places available on each tour and the prices are based on 40 students attending.

If there are less than 40 students the price may be increased.

Please check the GTI information sheets for further information about the tours.

Three links will be made available to parents on Monday 2nd September at 17:00.

These links will close when deposits have been paid for all 40 places on each trip or on Thursday 5th September 2025 at 21:00. A waiting list will then operate.

*We are awaiting confirmation of the dates for deposit for the Berlin trip – a text will be sent if the Berlin deposit date changes from above.

If there is a great demand for one of the tours there may be a review of the capacity subject to flight availability and supervisor availability.

Please be aware that the Code of Behaviour has been reviewed. In section 8.4 the Code of Behaviour outlines that no student can go on an extra curricular trip if they are on Ceannaire Diary or have been suspended during the school year or have unauthorised student absence on their profile. Please discuss this with your son/daughter before paying the deposit. If your son/daughter is suspended prior to the tour, the deposit may be lost if there is no-one on the waiting list to take their place.

All student direct costs must also be paid in full prior to going on any school tour.
